



# Teen Room Code of Conduct

Created in partnership with DeKalb teens. Updated 3/2/18

## WE RESPECT.....

- ◆ each other by not cursing or yelling and by not making racial, sexual, or anti-LGBT comments
- ◆ library space by limiting groups in teen study rooms to **four** or fewer individuals, by using space for visiting and collaboration only—not for dancing or horseplay, and by cleaning up after ourselves
- ◆ each other by keeping our hands to ourselves and saving public displays of affection for places other than the library
- ◆ library space and do not run, jump, throw things, stand on furniture, or roll chairs around

## WE CAN....

- ◆ have covered drinks and non-messy snacks if they are kept away from books and equipment and if we clean up after ourselves
- ◆ express our opinion or displeasure in a respectful way
- ◆ play music, unless it becomes disruptive to others
- ◆ share our ideas with library staff to make the library space and programs even better for teens

## ONE AND DONE CONSEQUENCES

Library staff offer one warning for misbehavior.

The decision to act appropriately is up to you.

Consequences for misbehavior include being asked to leave the library for the rest of the day or for a longer period of time.

If you are asked to leave, you will need to stay off of library property, both inside and out.
